SECTION I

Students must comply with all Board policies and procedures for use of the student activities Fund 200 and shall remain under the direction of school staff at all times.

WHEREAS, the St. Bernard-Elmwood Place City School District Board of Education has been advised that immediate repairs must be made to facilities at St. Bernard-Elmwood Place High School due to storm water damage that recently occurred ("Project") as a result of an unanticipated natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, compliance with the bidding requirements of Ohio Revised Code section 3313.46 to bid the Project would unduly delay the completion of the Project and interfere with the efficient and safe operation of the school buildings.

The Treasurer and Superintendent are hereby authorized to solicit proposals for the Project and are further authorized to execute any contracts necessary to complete the Project with the contractors deemed most suitable for the work by the Superintendent and Treasurer, suitability being based, in part, on price and prior experience performing the same work.
