B. Approval of the OAPSE Reopener One-Year Contract Amendment

It is recommended that the OAPSE Reopener One-Year Contract Amendment be approved as follows:

This Amendment to Agreement by and between the ST. BERNARD-ELMWOOD PLACE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION (hereafter the “Board”) and the OHIO UNION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES LOCAL #622 (hereafter the “Union”),

WHEREAS, the Board and the Union are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement (hereafter the “Agreement”), the effective dates of which are July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018;

WHEREAS, the Agreement contains a reopener provision relating to wages for the 2017-2018 school year;

WHEREAS, the parties have engaged in those reopener negotiations and have reached a settlement.

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend Agreement based on that settlement.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby AGREED as follows:

1. The salary schedule for bus drivers shall be increased at each step by fifty cents (\$.50). The salary schedule for paraprofessionals shall be increased by thirty cents (\$.30) at each step.
2. After the application of the increase set forth in Paragraph 1, the hourly wages set forth in all of the salary schedules shall be increased by two percent (2%) for the 2017-2018 school year.
3. All other terms and conditions not specifically addressed herein shall remain unchanged.

C. Approval of Senate Bill 210 Nutrition Compliance Report

It is recommended that the following Senate Bill 210 Nutrition Compliance Report be approved as follows:

St. Bernard-Elmwood Place City Schools Board of Education Policy - EF

As mandated by SB 210, beginning July 2011 all schools must meet certain nutrition standards on all “a la carte” foods sold during the school day. This impacts the St. Bernard-Elmwood Place Child Nutrition Department as well as all vending and any school stores.

We are pleased to report that the St. Bernard-Elmwood Place Cafeteria has continued to meet these guidelines this school year. All of the “a la carte” snacks sold in the lunchrooms meet the Alliance for a Healthier Generation guidelines and per Board policy, all beverages meet SB 210 guidelines.

School principals are responsible for overseeing vending machines and school stores in their respective buildings. Our principals are pleased to report that their schools are also in compliance.

D. Resolution Authorizing Membership in the Ohio High School Athletic Association

By resolution, the Board of Education of the St. Bernard-Elmwood Place City School District authorizes membership in the Ohio High School Athletic Association for schools under its jurisdiction. Schools eligible for membership are those that include one or more grades at the 7-12 level. It is agreed that these schools will conduct their athletic programs in accordance with the Constitution, Bylaws, Regulations, Interpretations, and Decisions of the Ohio High School Athletic Association. This resolution shall remain in effect for the school year 2017-2018.
